


## Who are the best people to talk to in school about my child's difficulties with learning/Special Educational Needs?



Class teacher: If you feel that your child may have SEND then you should ask to speak to your child's class teacher in the first instance.

SENDCo: Mrs Lockwood is our SENDCo who works closely with class teachers to put in place strategies and interventions to help remove your child's barriers to learning. She has the National Award for Special Educational Needs Coordination.

Inclusion manager: Mrs Dean is our Inclusion Manager. She works closely with your child's teachers to track your child's progress in school and organise extra support if your child is falling behind. She leads the Inclusion Team ensuring the best provision for all children.

Learning Mentor: Mrs Sayles works with children in and out of class who are having difficulties with behaviour, learning or need emotional support. She also runs groups for children to help them cope with change and challenging situations such as transition to secondary school.

**Parent Support Advisor:** Mrs Horbury is our Parent Support Advisor. Within school she leads on Solihull parenting course. Mrs Horbury provides lots of support for families and children and can signpost you to local services such as children centres, legal advice and Family Learning.

SEN Governor: Our SEN Governor challenges school to ensure children's needs are being met and shares this information with the Governing Body.
