

Dear Families,

As the summer holidays are coming towards the end, I would like to share with you some important information about your children returning to school.

Children will start school on Thursday 3rd September. To minimize the number of children and adults gathering together at any one time, we have staggered the start and finish times of our school day.

Can we please ask that children remove any face coverings before they enter the school grounds.

Children will be asked to wash their hands before they enter their classrooms.

To limit the number of adults in school, we are asking parents not to enter their child's classroom. Members of staff will greet the children as they arrive at their entry door and we would politely ask that parents leave the school grounds immediately after drop off.

We would ask the parents of children in Years 5 and 6 to say goodbye to their children at the main gate and for them to walk down the path to the car park door themselves.

There will be lots of members of staff to greet the children and point them in the right direction if they are unsure where to go.

Speaking to the Teacher

If you would like to speak to your child's class teacher or a member of the leadership team, can we ask that you please make an appointment through the school office who will be happy to arrange this for you.

School Crossing

The School Crossing Lady will be on duty from 8.15am – 9am in the morning and from 2.55pm – 3.30pm in the afternoon.

School Uniform

When children return to school in September, they are expected to wear school uniform. For your information, our uniform is:

- Black or grey trousers / skirt
- White/pale blue polo shirt / shirt
- Royal blue jumper or cardigan
- Black Shoes

Trainers and jewellery, except plain stud earrings are not permitted.

PE Kits – Plain white T Shirt, plain navy blue / black shorts, trainers or pumps, plain dark coloured tracksuit for cold weather.

Uniform can be bought from Vartex who deliver direct to the school. Order forms are available on the school website.

Children will be provided with all the equipment they need in their class bubbles and are asked not to bring pencil cases into school. We ask that they only bring their book bags, reading records, packed lunches and PE kits into school. Children in early years should also bring their wellies and waterproof coats for outdoor learning.
