Children must continue to learn with their teacher online, every day.


- **What if I don't have a computer or Ipad?**

## • Staying Safe

When children are in school, they will remain with their class bubble. They will not mix with any other children in other classes or year groups.



Children will remain in their own classrooms throughout the day. They will also eat their lunches in the classroom.



Children will spend break times with their class bubbles only.



Cleaning staff are on site throughout the day. Classrooms are cleaned before school, at lunchtimes and breaktimes. Toilets are cleaned frequently throughout the day.

Everyone will wash their hands regularly throughout the day.
