Our learning for the next half term...

Reading

We are going to continue to develop the ability of the pupils to read texts fluently and accurately and build up their understanding of what the text tells them through building a situation model. The pupils will also continue to develop their comprehension skills.

Writing

In writing, we are going to be learning how to write an Arabian Nights Tale developing the skill of using dialogue to move the action forward.

Maths

Year 4 will be deepening their understanding of multiplication and division through developing written methods for both operations and developing their understanding of fractions.

Science

Our unit of science for this half-term is The Particle Model. The pupils will learn how the particles in solids, liquids and gases are arranged and how they change state.



Geography

Our next unit will focus on the Tropical Rainforests. The unit will focus on the reasons for the distribution of them in the world and what it is like in the tropical rainforests.

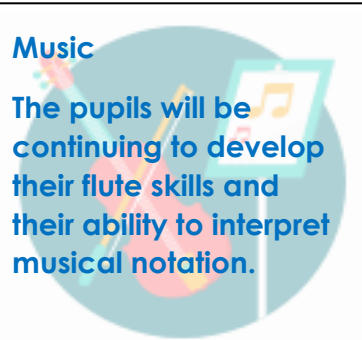


Art

In Art, we will look at the work of Abel Rodríguez and Henri Rousseau to create a botanical piece using watercolours.

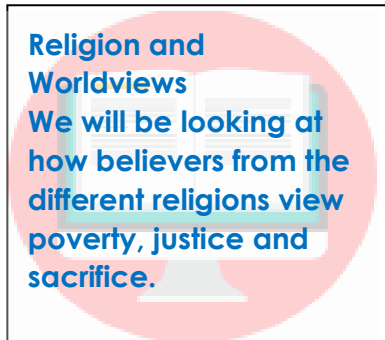
Music

The pupils will be continuing to develop their flute skills and their ability to interpret musical notation.



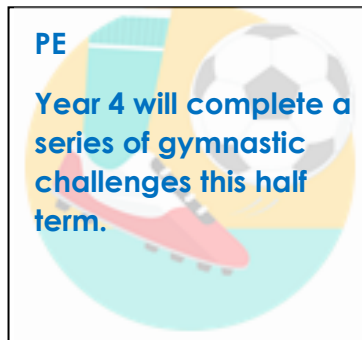
Religion and Worldviews
