- Every child **reads with an adult regularly**, and we share stories together daily to foster a deep love of books and reading for pleasure.
- Our **literacy lessons** are built around high-quality texts, linked to exciting topics. We follow the sequence of *gather*, *skills*, *apply* to build strong readers and confident writers.
- In **maths**, children explore concepts in depth through engaging, practical activities. We use concrete resources to support understanding and encourage mathematical talk and reasoning.
- Topics are carefully chosen to follow the **interests of the children**, helping to inspire and motivate them to become inquisitive learners.
- We weave in real-life experiences that help make learning meaningful and memorable.

As part of our Hunningley family, Year 2 children are also given a wide range of opportunities that support their **personal growth**, including:

- Taking part in **extra-curricular clubs** to explore personal interests and talents.
- Performing on stage in our Christmas and Summer events.



- Reading books by over 20 different authors across the year.
- **Planting seeds** and learning how things grow.
- Exploring our **local history** and how our community has changed over time.
- Becoming artists by creating a collage inspired by The Great Fire of London.
- Representing our school at academic and sporting events, showing teamwork and pride.
