Our learning for the next half term...

Reading

We will develop our work on becoming fluent readers. We will study a range of words and their etymology and create situation models to help us understand many genres of writing.

Writing

In our writing lessons, we will begin by embedding our Hunningley
Fundamentals of Writing. This will include developing our knowledge of spelling, punctuation and grammar so that we understand what a sentence must include.

Maths

In maths, we will develop our existing knowledge of place value. We will further develop our understanding of partitioning and representing numbers up to 1,000.

Science

Our first Science unit will explore Rocks. We will compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties. We will also describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock.

Geography

In Geography, we will name and locate counties and cities of the United Kingdom, geographical regions and their identifying human and physical characteristics.

In music, we will explore a range of ballads.
