Our learning for the next half term...

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Reading

We will develop our understanding of vocabulary and etymology to derive the meaning of new words. We will also improve our reading fluency across a range of texts whilst developing the comprehension skills needed to become an efficient reader.

Writing

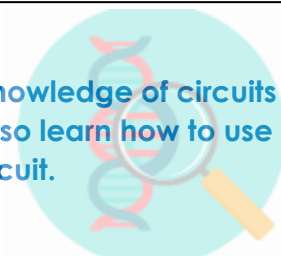
In our first writing unit, we will master the fundamental skills required to be a coherent and effective writer. After that, we will write to inform using 'Fantastic Beasts' by JK Rowling to inspire a non-chronological report.

Maths

In maths, we will develop our existing knowledge of place value and develop our ability to use the written methods for all four operations including calculating with fractions. We will also look at measurement and converting units.

Science

In science, we will be building on our Year 4 knowledge of circuits exploring parallel and series circuits. We will also learn how to use symbols to represent the different parts of a circuit.



History

Building on our Year 5 knowledge of the Romans, we will learn about the next settlers in England: The Anglo Saxons.

We are learning how to make hats using a range of stitching methods. We will learn how to design, create and evaluate a head covering.

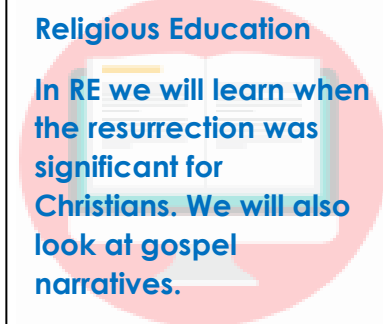
Music
