

Curriculum Newsletter: Year 6

Our learning for the next half term...

Reading

We will continue to develop our retrieval, vocabulary and inference skills in a variety of narrative and information texts which will help prepare us for our future writing units.

Writing

This half term our writing is inspired by 'The Arrival' by Shaun Tan. We will be focussing on multi-genre writing to tell a story using narratives, diaries, and letters.

Maths

In maths, we will be building on our prior knowledge to convert metric units and develop our understanding of imperial measurements. We are then going to learn about ratio and algebra.

Science

We are learning about 'Light' this half term. We are going to build on our Year 3 knowledge of light to understand how shadows are made, the parts of the eye and how we can see different colours.

Geography

This half term we are learning about migration and why people chose to move to a different country including push and pull factors.

DT

We are going to be learning how to design a sustainable system building on our knowledge in Geography.

Music

We will learn how composers use minor and major scales to compose film soundtracks.

Religious Education

In RE we will learn how Hindus create a sense of community through their religious festivals Diwali and Holi.

PE

We will develop the skills needed to link and combine actions to create a sequence in gymnastics

PSHE

We will be learning more about how to keep our bodies healthy including our mental and physical health.
