

Curriculum Newsletter: Year 2

Our learning for the next half term...

Reading

We will continue to develop our work on becoming fluent readers. We will study a range of words and create situation models to help us understand many genres of writing. We are focusing upon informative writing.

Writing

In writing, all children in Year 2 are focusing upon the unit of work 'Writing to Inform'. Following on from our Geography learning, the children are going to write a letter to a known audience sharing lots of information about the Sahara Desert.

Maths

In maths, we will develop our existing knowledge of shape, money and multiplication and division. The children will learn and recognise 2D & 3D shapes, counting and recognising money and developing their ability to count groups of certain numbers and divide by these numbers too.

Science

In Science, the children are focusing and learning about the topic of 'Uses of Everyday Materials'. The children learn about the different properties that materials can have.



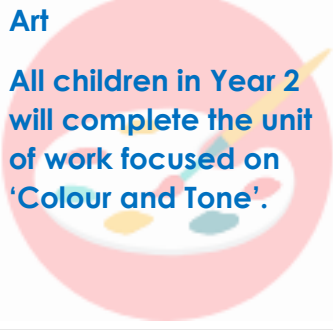
Geography

All children in Year 2 will complete the unit of work focused on 'Colour and Tone'.



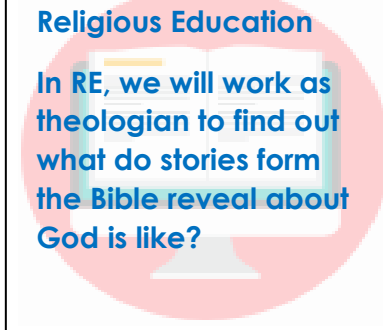
Music

This half term, the children are focusing on exploring Feelings through Music



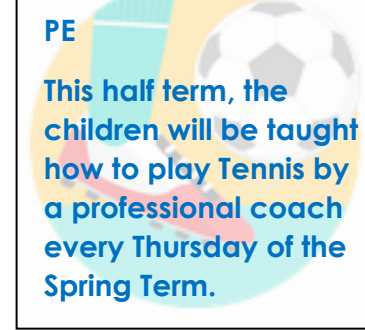
Religious Education
